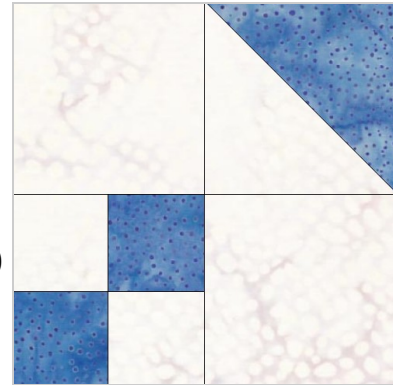


Two Part Four Patch

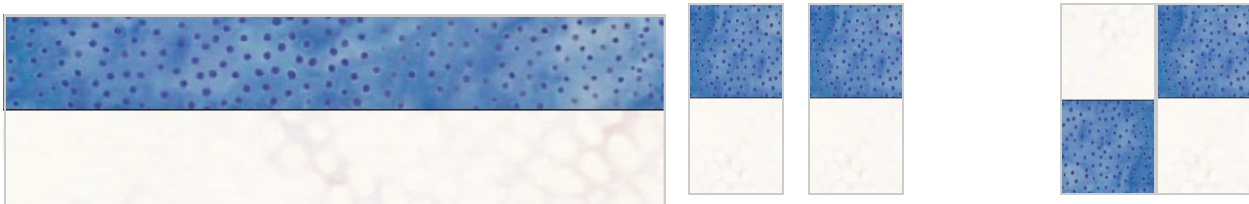
Assemble:

- (4) 4" **background** squares (from the 9-1/2" strip)
- (16) 3-1/2" **background** squares (from the 9-1/2" strip)
- (1) 2" x WOF **background** strip
- (1) 2" x WOF **blue** strip
- (4) 4" **blue** squares (from the first clue)

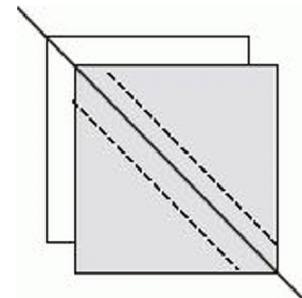


Make 8

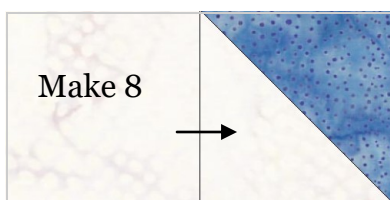
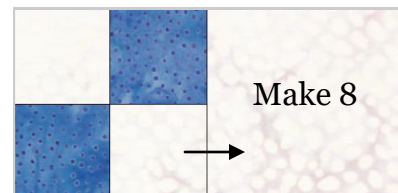
Sew the two 2" strips together. Press to the dark. Cross cut every 2" to make (16) two-patch blocks. Use these two-patch blocks to make the (8) four-patch blocks. Press and square up to 3-1/2" if necessary.



There are many different ways to make HSTs. This is the traditional method. To create these blocks, place a 4" x 4" blue fabric square right sides together with a 4" x 4" Background square. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the background squares. Sew 1/4" on both sides of that diagonal line. Cut on the line and press to the dark. Make (8) HSTs. *Square up the HST blocks to 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" unfinished.*



Sew the four-patch blocks to a 3-1/2" background square. Press.



Sew the HST blocks to a 3-1/2" background square. Press.

Use these units to make 8 blocks like the one at the top of the page.
