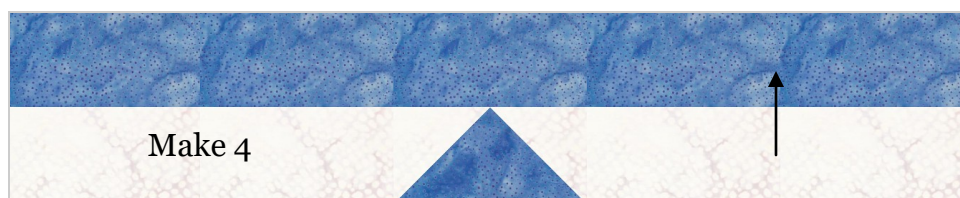


Adding the borders

Assemble:

- The center you just made
- The (4) remaining square in a square blocks
- (4) long flying geese blocks
- (4) $3\text{-}1/2'' \times 30\text{-}1/2''$ **blue** rectangles
- (2) $2\text{-}1/2'' \times 42\text{-}1/2''$ **blue** rectangles
- (2) $2\text{-}1/2'' \times 46\text{-}1/2''$ **blue** rectangles.

First and Second Border: Sew the $3\text{-}1/2'' \times 30\text{-}1/2''$ blue rectangle to the top of the Flying Geese block, taking care to match the center of the rectangle with the center of the goose block.



Sew one these borders to each side of the center, keeping the blue to the outside. Press to the border.

Sew a square in a square block to both ends of two of the remaining two borders, matching the design as shown below. Press to the border.



Sew this to the top and bottom of your new center. Press. Your center should now measure $42\text{-}1/2'' \times 42\text{-}1/2''$.

Outer Border: Sew a $2\text{-}1/2'' \times 42\text{-}1/2''$ rectangle to both sides, taking care to match the center of the rectangle with the center of the quilt top. Press to the border.

Sew a $2\text{-}1/2'' \times 46\text{-}1/2''$ rectangle to both the top and bottom of your new quilt top, again taking care to match centers. Press. You are done! Quilt as desired and don't forget to add a label.
