## Fabric Requirements

2/3 yard Fantasia-C3133 Multi
1/4 yard each:
Tonga-B2961 Red
Tonga-B3161 Love
Tonga-B3167 Lime
Tonga-B2582 Sun
Tonga-B2048 Envy
Fantasia-C3134 Yellow
15/8 yards Fantasia-C3136 Blue
1/2 yard Tonga-B3169 Poppy (binding)
$3^{1 / 8}$ yards backing fabric of your choice
$55^{\prime \prime} \times 73^{\prime \prime}$ batting

## Cutting

Label pieces as indicated as you cut to make it easier to assemble the quilt.

## From Fantasia-C3133 Multi:

- Cut seven $3^{1 / 1 " 4} \times 42^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, keeping them in order and labeling them 1 to 7 . Place the label near the top of the print to keep the strips properly oriented.
From both Tonga-B2961 Red and Tonga-B3161 Love:
- Cut two $2^{11 / 2 " ~ x ~ w i d t h-o f-f a b r i c ~(W O F) ~ s t r i p s . ~ S u b-c u t ~ o n e ~}$
 strip (F) and one $2^{1 / 2 " 1} \times 33^{1 / 2 " 1}$ strip.
From both Tonga-B3167 Lime and Tonga-B2582 Sun:
- Cut three $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew two of the strips together end to end with a diagonal seam and cut a $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 53^{1 / 2 "}$ strip. From the leftover scrap and the remaining strip, cut one $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 33^{1 / 2 "}$ strip, cut two $2^{1 / 2 "}$ squares (D), two $2^{11 / 2 "}$ x $3^{1 / 2 " 1}$ strips (E) and two $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{1 / 2 " ~ s t r i p s ~(F) . ~}$
From both Tonga-B2048 Envy and Fantasia-C3134 Yellow:
- Cut two $2^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF strips, sub-cut into one $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square (D), one $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (E) and one $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ strip (F). Sew the leftover scrap of the two matching strips with a diagonal seam and cut a $2^{11 / 2 " ~} \times 53^{1 / 2 "}$ strip of both prints. From Fantasia-C3136 Blue:
- Cut the following strips length of fabric:
~ Four $1^{1 / 2 "}$ strips. Sub-cut two $1^{1 / 1 / 2 "} \times 53^{1 / 2 "}$ strips, two $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 33^{1 / 2 "}$ strips, eight $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (B) and four $1^{1 / 2 "}$ " squares (C).
~ Six 2" x 53¹/2" strips.
~Two 27/8" x 53¹/2" strips.
~ Four 2½" strips. Sub-cut two 21/2" x 53¹/2" strips, two $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 33^{1 / 2} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, four $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (A).
~ Two $3^{1 / 1 / 4 " ~ s t r i p s . ~ S u b-c u t ~ t h e ~ f o l l o w i n g ~ r e c t a n g l e s: ~ t w o ~}$

 two $3^{1 / 4 "}$ " squares.

From Tonga-B3169 Poppy:

- Cut six $2^{1 ⁄ 21}$ x WOF strips.


## Corner Block Assembly

Refer to the quilt photo for color placement. Arrange the fabric pieces for each of the four corners before beginning the directions below to be sure the correct $D, E$ and $F$ patches are used in each corner. Note: there are four different corner blocks. Press all seams in the direction of the arrows.

1. Sew a $21 / 2$ " C3136

Blue A square to a colored $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{D}$ square. Add a $1^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 ½$ " C3136 Blue B rectangle. (figure 1)
2. Sew a colored $21 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ $51 / 2$ F strip to the right side of the unit made in step 1. (figure 2)
3. Sew a $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2$ " C3136 Blue B rectangle to a colored $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ D square. (figure 3)

4. Sew a colored $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ E strip to the bottom of the unit made in step 3. (figure 4) 5. Sew a $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ C3136 Blue $C$ square to a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
fig. 4 x $51 / 2$ " colored F strip with a half-seam. (figure 5) Press seam away from the small square.
6. Sew a $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ " colored strip E to the right of the unit made in step 5. (figure 6)
7. Sew the BDE section from step 4 to the top of the section from step 5. (figure 7)

8. Sew the ADBF section from step 2 to the left of the section from step 7. (figure 8)
9. Finish the half seam to complete the Corner Block. Note that each corner block is has a different grouping of colors to coordinate with the quilt borders, and should measure $71 / 2$ " square.
Quilt Top Assembly
Piece the quilt center section as follows, referring to the quilt photo as needed for orientation and color placement.
10. Add the following C3136 Blue pieces to the numbered 31/4" x $421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ C3133 Multi strips as follows:
~\#1, $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top and a $31 / 4$ " $\times 9^{1} / 2$ " rectangle to the bottom
~\#2, $31^{1 / 4}$ " $\times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top and a $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2$ " rectangle to the bottom
~\#3, $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top and a $31 / 4$ " square to the bottom.
~\#4, $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top and a $31 / 4$ " $\times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the bottom
~ \#5, $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top, and a $31 / 4$ "x $41 / 2$ " rectangle to the bottom
~\#6, $31 / 4$ " square to the top and a $31 / 4$ " x $81 / 2$ " strip to the bottom ~ \# 7, $31 / 4$ " $\times 91 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and a $31 / 4$ " $\times 21 / 2$ " rectangle to the bottom
11. Keeping the C3133 Multi strips in numerical order, sew them together with C3136 Blue 2" x $53 \not 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips in between. Add a $27 / 8$ "x $531 / 2$ " C3136 Blue strip to the left and to the right sides of the pieced panel. Press all seam allowances toward the C3136 Blue fabric.
12. Piece the right and left side border strips, and the top and bottom border strips as shown in the quilt photo, using the remaining $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " and $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ C3136 Blue strips and the remaining colored strips. Press seams toward the C3136 Blue fabric. Label the borders by location.
13. Sew the right and left side border strips to the center section. Press seams toward the center section.
14. Sew the corner blocks to the appropriate corners of the top and bottom borders. Press seams toward the corner blocks.
15. Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt.


## Finishing

16. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.
17. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
18. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.

Note: This quilt is also shown in our Pandora and Botanic Garden collections, but the size of the center panels is different, so the directions differ slightly.
